General meetings normally held on the first Sunday of the even months (commencing February) offer members an opportunity to:

- Improve their knowledge about clocks, watches and horology
- Meet and interact with other members, both amateur and professional
- Obtain firsthand advice on repairs and local markets
- Obtain information on availability of spare parts and materials
- Socialize with other members

To help achieve this we also conduct workshops on movement repairs and case restoration on the odd months between general meetings. Each workshop features a guest speaker for the day.

3. Chapter Library

The Chapter library is the best local reference source of books, videos, DVDs and magazines on clocks, watches and horology in general. These are available for loan at meetings and also by arrangement with our Librarian.

4. Chapter Newsletter

Designed and published in colour, three issues per year are distributed prior to general meetings. It includes articles on clocks, watches, horology in general, information from previous meetings, book reviews, speaker's comments, future meetings and upcoming events (includes dates and venues).

5. Annual Auction

The Chapter holds an Annual Auction, usually in April, allowing the Chapter Members to sell/ buy at auction all types of clocks, watches, parts, tools, and books to add to their collection.
